²³And Jesus went about all Galilee, ^ateaching in their synagogues, preaching ^bthe gospel of the kingdom, ^cand healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. ²⁴Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they ^abrought to Him all sick people who

were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them. ^{25a}Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and *from* Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.
